

MIXOLO PRIVACY POLICY

Mixolo, Inc. (also DBA Mixolo) ("us", "we", or "our") operates web and mobile applications as an event organizer, aggregator and concierge for our customers (members) helping them find solo-friendly events and experiences, matching them with select third-party hosts (the "Service").

This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information when you use our Service.

We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

We use your Personal Information for providing and improving the Service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions, accessible at mixolo.io

Information Collection and Use

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. We collect this information for the purpose of providing the Service, identifying and communicating with you, responding to your requests/inquiries, servicing your purchase orders, and improving our services.

We store data in our backend databases related to the information you provide when creating your profile/account for Mixolo (email, password authentication, birthdate, first and last name, phone number. When using our web and mobile applications, purchases, payment methods, event reviews and other helpful information may also be stored to ensure a smooth user experience (customer satisfaction and targeted marketing based on interests defined by the user) and to support our accounting systems (tracking event sales, refund and credit activity).

Mixolo may also share broad demographics on our group to potential hosts and sponsors for Mixolo events and experiences to bring our members more services.

Log Data

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service ("Log Data"). This Log Data may include information such as your mobile device ID, computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

In addition, we may use third-party services such as Google Analytics that collect, monitor and analyze this type of information in order to increase our Service's functionality. These third-party service providers have their own privacy policies addressing how they use such information.

Cookies

Cookies are files with a small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and transferred to your device. We use cookies to collect information in order to improve our services for you.

You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. The Help feature on most browsers provides information on how to accept cookies, disable cookies or to notify you when receiving a new cookie.

If you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some features of our Service and we recommend that you leave them turned on.

Do Not Track Disclosure

We support Do Not Track ("DNT"). Do Not Track is a preference you can set in your web browser to inform websites that you do not want to be tracked.

You can enable or disable Do Not Track by visiting the Preferences or Settings page of your web browser.

Service Providers

We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate our Service, to provide the Service on our behalf, to perform Service-related services and/or to assist us in analyzing how our Service is used.

These third parties have access to your Personal Information only to perform specific tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use your information for any other purpose.

We are an event organizer, aggregator, and concierge for our members, helping them find solo-friendly events and experiences.

Mixolo curates events exclusive to Mixolo members and works to find other solo-friendly events and experiences for our members. We match our members with select hosts and partners.

When members purchase an event, we may share some basic information with our select partner hosts as needed (e.g. name and email address), so that hosts may make a reasonable effort to prepare for our members' participation and/or inform them of important information regarding the delivery of the event services.

Hosts who list events with Mixolo may require contact or personal information beyond those two basic categories in order to best serve our members. For example, travel companies may require phone contact information in order to text travel updates. Each event will require a certain level or different type of information to fully participate.

Mixolo provides an option for members who purchase events to identify any special needs they would like our hosts to know about. Members are not required to disclose any information and hosts, though we insist that they try, are not obligated to accommodate, except as the law may require.

Mixolo will not assume any responsibility for a member's choice to associate with a host or other third-party service provider through their product platform(s).

Communications

Mixolo may use your Personal Information to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by contacting us.

We require our hosts to provide an opt-out option for our members who have registered after the cancellation or successful completion of an event or experience. If a member does not opt-out, they may be opted into a mailing list for their host to continue communications.

Compliance with Laws

Mixolo will disclose your Personal Information where required to do so by law or subpoena or if we believe that such action is necessary to comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement or to protect the security or integrity of our Service.

Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, and we strive to implement and maintain reasonable, commercially acceptable security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the information we store, in order to protect it from unauthorized access, destruction, use, modification, or disclosure.

However, please be aware that no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure and we are unable to guarantee the absolute security of the Personal Information we have collected from you.

International Transfer

Your information, including Personal Information, may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside the United States and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the information, including Personal Information, to the United States and process it there and, where applicable, Mixolo will comply with European Union GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) standards.

Links to Other Sites

Our Service may contain links to other sites that are not operated by us. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site. We strongly advise you to review the Privacy Policy of every site you visit.

We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third-party sites or services.

Children's Privacy

Only persons age 18 or older have permission to access our Service. Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 13 ("Children").

We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 13. If you are a parent or guardian and you learn that your Children have provided us with Personal Information, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Information from any child under age 13 without verification of parental consent, we take steps to remove that information from our servers.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

We reserve the right to update or change our Privacy Policy at any time and you should check this Privacy Policy periodically.
